j. Statutory objectives of the Foundation:

The main statutory objective of the Foundation is to organize and to help those who disabilities and their families within the activities of public benefit.

The Foundation's objectives resulting from the activities of public benefit are:

- Promoting rehabilitation activities disabilities.

- Activating healthy people, and especially young people for rehabilitation activities;

- Initiating and supporting research activities and popular- scientific theory and the practice of rehabilitation of persons with disabilities;

- Protection and promotion of health

- Social assistance enables individuals and families to overcome difficult situations,

where they are not able to overcome using their own powers, resources and capabilities.

2. Rules, forms and scope of statutory activities

- Collect material and financial resources such as: donations, grants, legacies, public collections, bank.

- Cooperation with the authorities of local government, the state, the person legal and natural persons, sports clubs, associations.

- Providing organizational support and property to natural persons and legal persons and other bodies pursuing objectives of the Foundation.

- Organize conferences, symposia and seminars, and popular science devoted to the problems of people with disabilities;

- Provision of material assistance to people with disabilities in terms of projects undertaken by them rehabilitation and adaptation to normal functioning

- Scholarships and research funding in the field of rehabilitation of persons disabled.

- Organizing and financing operations, rehabilitation and medical.

- Transfer of funds allocated for accommodated necessities of life of individuals and families and enable them living in conditions equivalent to human dignity, bringing to life empowerment of individuals and families at the level of European standards;

- Organizing cultural events, tourist and sports involving persons disabled.

- The free activities of public benefit activities other membership organizations not elsewhere classified.

- Take other actions and measures related to the implementation of the objectives of the Foundation.

3. The main legal events in the activities of the Foundation with financial implications.

1. In 2014 the Foundation serviced 4 434 sub-accounts to help people with disabilities and their families raising funds for medical treatment, rehabilitation and purchase of equipment. The Foundation conducted free of charge account maintenance, do not charge a commission or charges from donors or foundations. All the funds on sub-accounts as a whole remained at their disposal. These funds are used by them primarily on the rehabilitation, expensive treatments, purchase of rehabilitation equipment, after the presentation of the Foundation relevant documents - invoices, bills. Foundation staff were constantly available to our pupils and their families, helping them and making it easier for social activity.

2. The Foundation is the organizer of a number of projects aimed at supporting action dependents of parents in raising funds for treatment and rehabilitation of their children, such as festivals, charity concerts, sports marathons.

3. The Foundation provides financial assistance, which involves financing or co-financing the purchase of rehabilitation equipment, medicine and surgery, rehabilitation, medicines and hygiene materials, rehabilitation camps.

4. As part of a wide-ranging public benefit statutory activities conducted at Ryman free therapeutic activities and rehabilitation. Care was covered by 18 disabled persons with disabilities the severe and moderate and mild. Classes were conducted daily. Teaching therapeutic and rehabilitation both group and individual improve impaired body functions, they increase the level of psychomotor skills of people with intellectual disabilities, support existing social behaviors and learn new ones.

5. The guiding motto of the Foundation in 2014. Was "Burzymy Wall Autism". Prepared by our spot we crossed a positive verification of the National Council of Radio Broadcasting Commission and was accepted as part of the Social Campaign. We received free emission spot on antennas: TVP Info, TVP Historia, TVP Polonia, regional programs, as well as Polish Radio.

6. We also organized a course entitled "Burzymy Wall Autism" in Stawnica the lake Piaskowy. In a symbolic run special guests accompanied us Piotr Pogon and Bogdan Bednarz (the marathon), Czeslaw Mozil (singer, composer and musician, member of the jury of X Factor), residents Złotowa and surrounding areas, Sunshine Foundation's men, patients of the Centre "Zabajka" in Stawnica. The event was attended by over three hundred people. Proficient children, adults, teenagers efficient and disabled, in wheelchairs, on the hands of caregivers. There were a lot of positive energy, which allowed us to tear down the wall of autism.

7.For the fourth time took place in Little Film Festival Integration You and Me on 6 September at the headquarters of the Foundation. It was attended by our proteges, and patients Zabajka Center in Stawnica.
